



Sister Running Event Agreement

between

Guam Ko'ko' Road Race

and

Teganuma Eco Marathon

Whereas, the Teganuma Eco Marathon Secretariat, organizers of the Teganuma Eco Marathon, which is held in Kashiwa, Japan; and the Guam Visitors Bureau, organizers of the Guam Ko'ko' Road Race, which is held in Tumon, Guam herein known as "Parties" are completing this agreement to continue a good relationship between Guam and Kashiwa, Japan and Abiko City; and

Whereas, the parties agree to announce, the Guam Ko'ko Road Race and Teganuma Eco Marathon at each parties' respective race events with hopes to foster participation of runners from Guam and Japan to experience each parties' respective race events; and

Whereas, the parties agree to provide goods for the winning runner at each parties' respective race event; and

Whereas, this official launch will commence in FY2012 for the next three (3) years. However, this Agreement expiration date will automatically be extended unless either party elects to terminate the Agreement with a three (3) month notice prior to the expiration date; and

Whereas, this Agreement is not exclusive and both parties agree the Guam Visitors Bureau is eligible to support other Marathon's, Half Marathon's and/or Ekiden's related events outside of the Kashiwa Chiba region; and

Whereas, parties shall negotiate in good faith to resolve any conflicts and parties agree any amendments must be agreed to in writing; and

Now Therefore, the Guam Visitors Bureau and the Teganuma Eco Marathon Secretariat do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Running Events, and declare their intent to abide by this Agreement.

This Agreement goes into effect on the date of signature, and is written in both English and in Japanese with both texts having equal power.
