

To all residents of Kashiwa City:

This is a message from the mayor of Kashiwa City, Mr. Hiroyasu Akiyama.

A state of emergency was announced by the nation on July 30. Following this announcement, Chiba Prefecture has set out a request for cooperation starting today, and extending to August 31.

The number of people infected with the virus is currently increasing across the country, and Chiba Prefecture, including Kashiwa City, is no exception.

I understand that everyone has already made great efforts to prevent the spread of Covid-19. I would like to ask for your further understanding and cooperation regarding the following Covid-19 prevention measures based on the request from Chiba Prefecture.

○Please refrain from non-essential and non-urgent outings and travel during the daytime, including the Obon holidays and summer vacation.

○If you interact with people outside your home, limit it to a small number of family members or people you would normally meet in your day-to-day activities.

○Avoid crowded places and time periods.

○Strictly avoid the use of restaurants, etc. that do not follow the request for preventive measures.

○Refrain from traveling between prefectures whenever possible.

○Regardless of the time of day or the place, eat and drink in silence, and wear a mask when you talk.

○Refrain from consuming alcohol in groups on the street or in parks.

Please cooperate with these measures to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in order to protect the lives of yourself, your loved ones, and others.
